## Evaluating your plates

<b>Colony numbers</b>	<b>Exposure Level</b>	<b>Guide to Exposure</b>
<b>0-3</b>	<b>Low</b>	Low or average exposure is completely normal with mould spores moving around freely in most environments.
<b>4-6</b>	<b>Average</b>	It is recommended that a test be performed outdoors for comparison with test carried out indoors
<b>7-12</b>	<b>High</b>	If high or very high exposure is indicated following completion of the test then this can indicate a mould problem in the room tested. A further investigation should be carried out at this point to establish the cause of the problem.
<b>13+</b>	<b>Very High</b>	It is recommended that a test be performed outdoors for comparison with test carried out indoors
